Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where can I find the CCRMP's that can nominate candidates for the CSCR through the Experienced Industry Professional pathway?

2. Some of my experience involves working on proprietary applications. Is it necessary to provide details that are proprietary in my application?

No.

3. Will the information in my application be publicly available?

No, only the members of the review committee will have access to your application.

4. I practice outside North America. Am I eligible to apply?

Yes. These credentials are designed to apply globally to those using catastrophe models and to catastrophe risk managers located in various regions throughout the world.

5. I am not sure whether I should nominate a candidate for the CCRMP or CSCR credential. Which one should I submit?

If you think the candidate may be eligible for the CCRMP, you should nominate him/her for the upper level credential. If the review committee finds the candidate does not fully qualify for the CCRMP, but meets all the criteria for the CSCR, they will recommend awarding the CSCR credential.

6. Is there a cost to apply through for Experienced Industry Professional?

There is no cost to apply. Once the EIP application is approved, candidates pay an annual \$350 credential program fee.
